

Jukai Sesshin 2015

Monday, March 16 – Sunday, March 22

Jukai is a public ceremony where individuals receive the Bodhisattva precepts and formally become Buddhists. Receiving Jukai at Dharma Rain is a personal step toward clarifying and deepening one's own intention to live as a Buddhist. All are welcome and encouraged to attend this ceremony and also the open retreat full or part time. The Jukai ceremony will take place at 11 AM on Sunday, March 22.

For the retreat, registration is only required for meals. Registration is not necessary for those who wish only to attend zazen and ceremonies. (See the schedule, and come in at the beginning of zazen, during kinhin, or the beginning of service.)

We won't have overnight accommodations for this retreat. Contact us for nearby motel recommendations. See the registration form for fees and various options for attendance. *The registration deadline is Wednesday, March 11.* An orientation letter will be sent to all registered participants prior to the sesshin.
