*Course Objective: Why Study Vow Practice and the Bodhisattva Vows?* Our objective is to move from a conceptual understanding of vow practice and the Bodhisattva Vows to an experiential relationship with these teachings. Small group discussions on focused questions will be a main strategy in nurturing that experiential relationship.

- □ **March 1**. Introduction: what's human behind "vows" and other similar words?
- □ **March 8**. Why Vow? Variation and motivations in Buddhist approaches.
- □ **March 15**. How we practice with vow at Dharma Rain.
- March 22. The Four Bodhisattva Vows. Introduction. History; various perspectives on these vows; why these vows might find a place in your practice.
- March 29. The Four Bodhisattva Vows. In depth discussion of the first 2 vows: 1) Beings are numberless; I vow to free them. 2) Delusions are inexhaustible; I vow to end them.
- April 5. The Four Bodhisattva Vows. In depth discussion of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4th vows: 3) Dharma gates are boundless; I vow to enter them.
   4) The Buddha way is unsurpassable; I vow to realize it. Experimenting with finding our own version of the Four Bodhisattva Vows.
